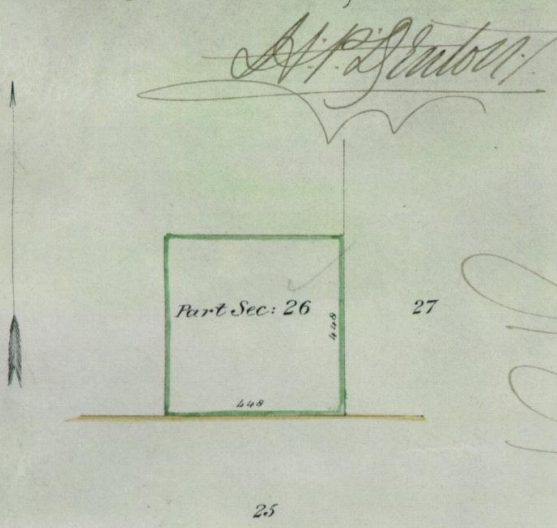
Carl Christian Ahms of near Hutton Farmer is now seized of an estate in fee simple subject nevertheless to such encumbrances liens and interests as are notified by memorial underwritten or endorsed hereon in that piece of land situated in the Hundred of Saddleworth County of Light being the South easternmost corner of the section numbered 26 in the said Hundred and bounded as appears in the plan in the margin hereof and therein coloured green WHICH said piece of land contains two acres or thereabouts and measures as well on the North side next other part of the said section as on the South side next a Government Road severally four chains and forty eight links or thereabouts and as well on the East side next portion of section 27 as on the West side next other portion of the said section 26 severally four chains and forty eight links or thereabouts WHICH said section No 26 is delineated in the Public Map of the said Hundred deposited in the office of the Surveyor General and was originally granted the fourth day of July 1855 under the hand and seal of Sir Richard Graves Mac Donnell Governor in Chief of the said Province to Peter Dowding Frankford and Alfred Treaver.
