### **2. Reports (non-Peak body)**

- Saddleworth & District Historical Society.  
Museum still going along, the Old School sale is still a possibility emailed Fiona re the sale of old School – Valuation \$60,000 from Council – counter offer to Fiona, rang preferred Land Agent - Fiona hopefully will make a further offer – and if it is sold to her it is to be used for a writers workshop or for the community to use for art

### 3. Other Business:

- Kenton - Web site: Very quiet – feedback slow.
- Town Information sheet on an A4 size – Library have been helpful. Library will print and Laminate for free -
- Kenton spoke on the proposal to have a Youth Group in Saddleworth as there is nothing for the younger children, and only 11 years and upwards can attend the CFS Cadets. Scouts at Riverton are not supported by Saddleworth Children, - only sports groups– Inter church group is very church orientated – Pastor Leon has offered facilities - Jess Crane is interested in helping - Suggested Kenton contact Colleen Noble and see what could be possible for our town with a Young Youth Group. Colleen is the Council Youth person.
- Cemetery Fence needs to be removed - after we had made contact with Martin Smith.
- Undayla produce Kenton spoke about the produced available there, Milk, Cider and Honey.
- Hub Shop – slower month in Oct – picking up again – first successful months – so rent has been paid and accounts all paid.
- Bank card account these funds are being held in reserve.
- 6 months be up at the end of the year.
- Volunteers - Progressing.
- Phone call – Geoff Brock – about info of Peak Body.
- David Williams mentioned that the Saddleworth Bowling Club doing a great job for CFS Thanks from CFS to bowls club.
- Peak Body - New Secretary for the New Year - please, with the extra treasurers work, it would be good to have someone take on the Secretary work.
- Portia Stanton Noble, gave us a brief history of her time in moving here to Saddleworth.
- Ball for 2018 would be good, as the Museum has a record of the 1958 RSL Ball – we think that is what it is: May be a 60 Year celebration ball.
