- **Op Shop** – Running well, good sales, and good donations. Funded school children's visit to the Museum
- **Rec Ground** – The Cabin is up and running, with just some outside painting to be done, there has been a loan of \$5000 given, and this will be repaid as soon as practical, this has enabled us to complete the necessary work to the Cabin to enable it to be used. Barry Slattery the Caretaker of the Caravan Park, has retired, the committee are at present handling the park.
- **Winkler Park**- Still some plans in place for more work to be done, Andrew Wurst will follow up on that in the New Year.
- **Institute** - Still being used on a regular basis, disappointed that the school not using it this year for their concert.
- **Garden Group** – Watering being done regularly to keep plants alive – no major projects at the moment.
- **Historical Society** - Attended History Festival meeting at Riverton – decided to participate in 2019 festival – shared event with Riverton Group and the Rodeo museum at Marrabel. Window displays changing to suit events, the Remembrance Day display was very good.
Recent visit from the school: No further developments in the sale of the old school.
- **The Hub shop continues to run along quite well, opening on Saturdays and Sundays for passing traffic – also promoting the Antique Trail.**
