- 3. Shelter shed could be used for trading tables
- 4. Back end of block to be levelled and rubbish removed (Nobles have some of this cost covered)
- 5. Rose coloured gravel for the Sculpture area, then a few grass plants.
- 6. CWA table to be installed.
- 7. Small play equipment for toddlers near the shelter shed behind the path maybe rockers.
- 8. School children's large pavers area to be discussed.
- 9. Purchase lawn mower **As a result of meeting**.
- Quote re seating from Felton Industries but the thought was to get something in timber and a bit more stylish. Rosie to follow up.
- Quote re retaining wall accepted and give Pink's the go ahead.
- Quote for child rockers- considered too expensive.
