Garden Group

Historical Society

- Sign for the wall is complete (and was presented at the meeting) impressed with Signlab (both costs and workmanship)
- Museum will bear the costs of the wall sign as very reasonable and manageable
- Front verandah has been removed ready for renovation
- New replacement signage has been prepared to replace current old signage
- "Business as usual" even though there's temporary galvanised iron on the windows and no verandah!

Recreation Grounds and Workshop Group

- Busy time full house over the long weekend
- Cricket commences soon; oval currently being prepared
- Very positive feedback being received from locals and tourists alike

Bee and Hill Park:

- Windmill fan has been offered (proposed location near stone shed mounted to the wall)
- RSL seat plaque required and final location to be determined
- Sign for the name of the park to be finalised (A Nourse)

 - (RMcD) Whip Street Cemetery is looking untidy with overgrown grass(A Nourse to action both matters)
 - (AW) Trees 4 Life when will boxes be ready? (November J Naughton to collect)
 - (SS) Seniors units gardens looking quite shabby and weedy (J Wurst to contact Women and Junction Housing)
 - (PR) last meeting solar discussion occurred M l'Anson met with G Easthope at CGVC who is in favour of solar panelling at the Recreation Grounds. S Goodfellow (SGE) identified areas of value and savings of up to \$80 per quarter. Also provided two quotes on solar panelling and advice as to type etc. Pre-Safety Audit mandatory for Pavilion before proceeding with any installation. Cricket Club suitable now.
