tree removed near hotel in main street – stump needs grinding out – bunting currently around it for public WHS

Historical Society

- museum has re-opened on regular days

- will not open on market days unless a booking is confirmed

- working on quotes for replacing verandah and painting façade (and underpinning at left side of building)

- \$\$\$ from schoolhouse sale has been committed to any future building maintenance -schoolhouse sale and any remaining tasks have now been completed

Bee and Hill Park:

- working bee Sunday 30th August went well crusher gravel laid with use of a tractor; thanks to those who attended
- further working bee to install chairs and tables on Wednesday 2nd September
- another working bee will be needed to install the machinery and other items
- potential asset grant for paving of park through to Newark Street R Richardson will look into this
- Chinese elm is alive and well and ready for planting!
- Weeds at rear of block need to be sprayed (A Nourse)
- Rear fence screen of natives (Grevilleas for eg) and remove side fencing

- Nature play area for the rear of block (\$150 cash donation could go towards this)
- H Webb agreed to work on the corrugated fence and posts
- Lions Club Wall: discussion regarding water around foundations, could be an issue
 - ask S Noble to have a look and make recommendations (AN)
 - no building permit required building inspector has commented positively
 - work will commence soon looking for volunteers to help build the wall
 - a licensed builder has been sourced to provide support and direction
 - also looking for donations in the way of tiles (blue), concrete, sand and foundation rods

 - R Richardson volunteer hours from 18th July to 1st September amount to 69 hours
 - Thanks to the Clare & Gilbert Valleys Council for the 12 tonne crusher gravel
