Main Street Park Project - next stage

- To review, discuss and plan continuation of Main Street Park project;
- To celebrate current completion of project
- 1. Primary school pavers location? (24)
 - Around sundial and around the farm machinery
 - Be selective as to which one goes where
 - Need to be on a slant, cemented into the ground so they are not walked on and can be viewed by everyone

2. Sundial

- To be installed between lawn area and shelter
- Concreted in for safety and stability
- 3. One remaining tree to plant very large
 - Needs to be planted in a non-invasive area (towards the rear of the park?)
- 4. Three pieces of machinery
 - Behind the shelter shed on the levelled area
 - Cover the ground in rose gravel (same as around horse and dog)
- 5. Lions Club wall
 - Location along Newark Street pathway
 - To be low (1 metre in height) with displays cemented in to the top as opposed to front viewing
 - Lions would prefer it to be on an angle; Committee not in agreeance as could be a WHS risk and may interfere with other plans for the park.
- 6. Logo to be laser cut and placed on the frame of the shelter
- 7. Black boy plants (in metal) to be put near the horse and dog
 - One large and two small
 - Use the money from S Morris Hub Shop
- 8. Name of park with photo to be announced in the Plains Producer
- 9. Storage shed renovations lower the door / remove the stairs / fix the flooring
 - Potentially paint with stable doors to be aesthetically pleasing
- 10. Opening ceremony aim for September

- 11. Rocking toys about \$5000 each source funding
- 12. RSL Memorial to be placed at the front of park, left side corner
- 13. M l'Anson to donate excess hose for watering purposes and will organise for the tractor to be delivered
- 14. Signage for the park name to be designed and costed
